Dealer: Samuel Putnam Avery (1822-1904)¹

Specialty: Collector of etchings and lithographs, French prints.

Dealer History

Samuel Putnam Avery was a successful art dealer in New York whose passion for documenting the art of his time led him to collect 17,775 etchings and lithographs by 978 different artists. The rich collection—which was given to the New York Public Library in 1900—includes an especially large number of French prints. It includes over 400 etchings by Charles Jacque and Edouard Manet, as well as clichés-verre by Jean-Baptiste-Camille Corot, Charles-François Daubigny, Jean-François Millet, and Théodore Rousseau. American artists James McNeil Whistler and Mary Cassatt were also represented. The selection can be attributed both to Avery's own taste and network, as well as the importance of French printmaking in the second half of the 19th century.²

Avery was sponsored by the founder of Baltimore's Walters Art Gallery, W.T. Walters, to travel through Europe to purchase contemporary academic paintings for his customers. Throughout his time in Europe, he collected many prints that he later donated to the Library, as well as a collection of books on architecture that the Avery Library at Columbia University centers around.³
